GENERAL RULES - All Championships and Competitions will be conducted under the British Dance Council Rules governing the recognition of Championships. Trophies to be held for a period of Twelve Months. All Juvenile and Junior Competitors MUST hold a valid Licence as an Amateur. The role in which competitors commence the competition must be maintained throughout the event. No role changing during/mid dance. This rule applies to both members of the partnership. Any alteration to, or arrangements other than is provided for in such rules and regulations. shall be solely at the discretion of the Management of the Blackpool Dance Festival.

ENTRY - Direct entry for all Competitions must be made on the prescribed form, and such entry should reach the Organiser not later than Friday, 26th, June 2020. All entries, which will be acknowledged by post, must be signed by the parent or guardian. Should competitors not receive a letter of confirmation within seven days of the closing date please contact the Organiser. If any Competitor withdraws from any entry, immediate notification in writing should be made. Failure to do this renders them liable to disgualification from entering any future events. The Management reserve the right to limit the number of entries accepted in any of the Competitions. The decision of the Organiser is to be taken as final.

There will be an Entry Fee for each days competition which includes the General Admission to the Ballroom and all competitors will defray their own travelling expenses.

All Competitors must check their Confirmation to ensure names and events are correct. Should any details not be correct they must contact the Dance Festival Office immediately.

Entry to the Competitions will NOT be accepted unless it is accompanied by an Entry Fee Form.

Entry can be made online at www.blackpooldancefestival.com. Online entries are not acknowledged by the Dance Festival Office as a confirmation will be forwarded to your email address on completion

There will be NO REFUNDS on Season or Daily Admission Ticket (standing room only) including the Competitor Entry Fee if a Competitor withdraws.

AGE OF COMPETITORS: Competitors must be within the stated age group on the day of the event. Juniors must be over 12 and under 16 years of age for the Junior Championships and Competitions, and over 6 and under 12 years of age for the Juvenile Competitions and Championships. The group in which a couple may dance shall be determined by the elder member of the partnership. Proof of age must be available upon request - either BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR PASSPORT - Please note the special BDC ruling for 2020 events may apply – see below

PLEASE NOTE - No late entries will be accepted and there will be no spare numbers, nor will anyone be allowed to dance in place of competitors who have not claimed their numbers.

JUDGING - Should any adjudicator suffer illness we reserve the right to replace at any time. The aggregate votes of the Adjudicators in the Early Rounds, and the individual placings of each Adjudicator in the Final Rounds, will be available on the Official Dance Festival website.

TIMES OF COMPETITIONS - The Competition first round times will be available via the Blackpool Dane Festival website at least 2 weeks before the Festival. Competitors will be required to obtain their numbers from the Stewards AT LEAST 20 MINUTES BEFORE THE TIME OF THE COMPETITION.

Public and Competitors will be admitted on production of the Daily Ticket or Season Ticket without extra charge.

DRESS FOR JUVENILES - All competitors must dress in accordance with British Dance Council Rules (see Appendix 4). A copy of the Rules

and their clarification is enclosed with your Entry Form. Should there be any queries, please contact the Organiser.

EXTRA RULING FOR 2020 ONLY - Due to the world wide Coronavirus (COVID-19) many events are postponed until hopefully later in the year. The following emergency ruling will stand for any events affected by the government closure enabling the events to be migrated if the organiser wishes.

Age Groupings -

In effect from March 20th 2020 until UK Government restrictions are lifted With the compulsory closure of venues within the United Kingdom the following will apply to any postponed events which are run under British Dance Council Rules, if requested by the organiser.

Any event that is migrated to a new date within 2020 only, competitors may, if applicable dance in the age grouping of either the original date of the event in question or their new age grouping on the rescheduled date. In order for this to be permitted they must have entered the event as the same couple at the time of postponement, the organisers must request this ruling by letter, thus enabling this to be sanctioned by the British Dance Council. Competitors may only dance one age group on any day.
