Equality RULES.

The Equality section is for couples consisting of two females or two males. Trans (including non-binary) dancers who do not feel that their gender identity falls into either category may choose which category they feel most comfortable dancing in.

Changing lead and follow roles between or during dances is permitted.

There is no costume regulations in the Equality events although no indecent or inappropriate costumes will be allowed. Registering for Equality events is by self-classification. No choreographic restrictions apply in any levels. As a guide-
